course. After Completion of courses, the students need to undergo one year as working intern at IOCL (AOD) hospital. Working interns are provided free accommodation and monthly remuneration.

Eligibility criteria for admission: As per Indian

nursing council norms.

Annual Intake: 30 for GNM course & 30 for B.Sc.(N) course

NO fee: Fee for the students of AOCN & AOSN is fully financed by Indian Oil Corporation Limited, under corporate social responsibility (CSR). No Admission fee, Tuition/Training fee, Examination fee, clinical fee, university registration fee, Council registration fee, SNA subscription fee, Educational tour, workshop/ conferences conduction fee etc are bear by Indian Oil Corporation. During the course uniforms, books, educational materials, hostel accommodations, medical facilities are provided to the students free of cost. On other hand a handsome amount of monthly stipend is paid to the students from first year till completion of the course.

Theory classes: All the class rooms of AOSN & AOCN building are spacious



and equipped with modern teaching aids. Apart from the internal teachers with master in Nursing & PhD in nursing degree for all the Nursing departments, external teachers from Assam Medical College & Hospitals are engaged for specialized classes.



Laboratory classes: The nursing laboratories of AOSN & AOCN are equipped with the equipments & articles for demonstration classes. Qualified & experienced nursing teachers demonstrate the clinical procedures to the students & return demonstration taken from students prior to clinical posting.

AOCN Library: Nursing books for all five Nursing departments with recent edition are available in AOCN library. Both national & International nursing journals are available in AOCN library and students are encouraged to avail these books & journals.





<u>Clinical Posting:</u> For clinical experiences students are posted in 150 bedded parents Hospital of Assam Oil Division, Digboi CHC, Margherita FRU, Tinsukia District Hospital & Assam Medical College & Hospital.

<u>Academic achievements:</u> Every academic year students achieved university top ten position including university 1st position and students are awarded for achieving top ten positions in graduation day.

<u>Personality development:</u> Students are allowed and encouraged to take participation in various extracurricular related to the development of the society like swath Bharat abhiyan, Environmental Day, world health day, SNA conferences, state, National & International conferences etc., students are also funded for conduction of workshop/conferences etc.
